The TRP National Commission would like to advise of some important actions occurring for the remainder of 2020 leading into 2021. With a change of Olympics Cycle now officially being delayed for 1 year, and the adoption of next cycle's FIG Code of Points also being delayed until 2022, there will be no changes to Australian rules and regulations to this regard for 2021.

This news update provides a general understanding of the future direction to be aware of in your preparations for the remainder of the year and 2021.

Please note that while the commission endeavours to keep the community informed of the anticipated direction leading into the new cycle, the following information is subject to change and simply acts as a guide to what may occur.

Technical Regulations 2021

- Due for Completion - December 2020
- Due to the delayed release of the FIG Code of Points for the next cycle until 2022, there are no major or structural changes to rules for 2021 with the exception of conditional COVID Clauses

Qualifying for National Championships 2021

- As per the current Technical Regulations 2020 with conditional COVID Clauses

Competition Rules from now until Nationals Championships 2021

- as per Technical Regulations 2020 until the end of this year,
- and then by the yet to be released Technical regulations 2021 (aligned to the Technical regulations 2020 due to no FIG rule changes),
- aligned with the Australian Levels Program 2017-2020
- and the current FIG Code of Points 2017-2020

Competition Rules for National Championships 2021

- National Championships will operate under the current FIG Code of Points 2017-2020 as applied via the GA TRP Technical Regulations 2021 and ALP 2017-2020.

Competition Rules for National Clubs 2021

- National Clubs 2021 will operate as per the Technical Regulations 2021 (aligned to the Technical regulations 2020 due to no FIG rule changes)
- Aligned with the ALP 2017-2020
- and FIG Code of Points 2017-2020



Australian Levels Program (ALP) 2022 & Beyond

- Due for completion - End of 2021 to implement in 2022

Judging Courses

- Trampoline will be the first Gymsport to take Judging courses online with a Beginner Judge Course is currently in development.

Technology & Judging Software

- Sporttech will continue to be the scoring system for all Australian Trampoline events

High Performance Update National Squads 2021

- TRP will move to calendar squads in 2021 and the Commission is working with GA to determine if the same can be done for DMT and TUM.
- The National Commission are working alongside the GA staff to develop 2021 National Squad Policies
